

Report on Distribution of Essential Items at Flood-Affected Relief Camps

Location: Wangkhei, Imphal East

Date: 6th June 2025

In response to the recent floods that severely affected several localities in Imphal East, a distribution program of essential relief items was conducted at the relief camp situated in Wangkhei. The aim of the initiative was to provide immediate assistance and improve hygiene and nutrition for the displaced individuals, especially women and children.

Items Distributed:

Sanitary Pads: To promote menstrual hygiene and address the urgent needs of women and adolescent girls in the camp.

Phenyl (Disinfectant): To maintain sanitation and reduce the risk of disease outbreaks in and around the relief camp.

Biscuits: As ready-to-eat food items, biscuits were provided particularly for children and elderly people, to ensure quick energy and nutrition.

Beneficiaries:

Over 40 households (more than 140 people) residing in 2 relief camps benefited from this distribution. Special attention was given to women, children, and elderly persons who are more vulnerable during such calamities.

Purpose and Impact:

The initiative aimed at addressing basic needs and preventing the spread of infection due to poor sanitation. The distribution of sanitary pads ensured menstrual dignity for women, while phenyl helped in maintaining cleanliness in the shared living spaces. Biscuits provided a quick nutritional supplement for those unable to cook.

Conclusion:

This small but meaningful effort helped bring some relief and comfort to the affected individuals. More such interventions and continued support are needed to assist the flood victims in rebuilding their lives.
